- 1. Venue
  - a. Kelly put in a call to town hall in Bristol- waiting to hear back
  - b. Cassie got in touch with Common man- waiting to hear backi. Would common man donate h'oeuvres?
- 2. discussed time of day- evening with potluck or should we have it in the afternoon with light refreshments- unresolved
- 3. need to recruit local volunteers
  - a. Judy (not present) was suggested as possible leading a drum performance
  - b. Katy will ask Kelsey about any potential dance volunteers; Synergy dance as backup
- 4. Discussion of whether this should occur afterschool or weekend instead of during school- not teacher led- could be imposition on teachers
  - a. It would be a voluntary option for students who are interested

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- b. Students would also be encouraged to create their own performance pieces out of school- like a variety show
  - i. Would have to limit the number or allotted time for performances- by classroom?
- c. Students could create artwork outside of school as well for display in show
  - i. Artwork probably doesn't have to be limited as long as we have space to display
- 5. Robin suggested theme of "spring awakening"
  - a. Inspired by Calder's kinetic mobiles
  - b. Melting of snow, movement of awakening after winter
    - i. Art component could be creating mobiles inspired by spring movement in nature- wind, water, migration, animals, etc
    - ii. Robin would like to volunteer to help with this if she can make her schedule work
    - iii. Katy said that art *may* be able to be integrated into the classroom with some prior planning with the teachers
